


California Water Bond

On November 4, 2014, the voters of California approved a **\$7.545 billion water bond**.

The bond provides funds for:

- Water use Efficiency and Recycling
- Groundwater Cleanup and Management
- \$2.7 billion for additional Water Storage
- Invests in Safe Drinking Water
- Provides Watershed Restoration and Increased Flows

Sustainable Groundwater Management

For the first time in California history, the Sustainable Groundwater Management Act (SGMA) empowers local agencies to adopt groundwater management plans that are tailored to the resources and needs of their communities. Good groundwater management will provide a buffer against drought and climate change, and contribute to reliable water supplies regardless of weather patterns. California depends on groundwater for a major portion of its annual water supply, and sustainable groundwater management is essential to a reliable and resilient water system. 
